"We received a My Baby's Own Travel Chair to review and I was very impressed with how compact it is. Everything comes tucked inside an attached pocket for easy storage and transport. Setting it up was easy. However, what I liked best about My Baby's Own Travel Chair is that when you're done all you need to do is roll everything up and tuck it inside the attached case. I remember using more bulky high chair/shopping cart covers with my other daughters and it was always a pain to get everything stored when it was time to leave. I would end up just throwing the whole thing into the car and vowed to pack it up properly later. Of course, I never did. If you're worried about germs, safety, and portability when dining or shopping with your child, you owe it to yourself to check out My Baby's Own Travel Chair."



"The day I got my Snazzy Baby Travel Chair sample in the mail, I went to the store. Oh my goodness, talk about the most fantastic thing ever!! It so easy to use, and assembles in seconds. I just put it on the shopping cart seat, secured the support belt through the back of the cart, and fastened the clips. Then simply put my baby in, and clipped him in. I love the fact that it has secure shoulder straps, this prevents him from being able to put his head down and put his mouth on the cart. It's so easy to use, keeps him upright, comfy and eliminates the use of dirty shopping cart straps."



"The Snazzy Baby Knee Pads are really easy to put on, making the whole protection process very simple and hassle free, the protective cushioning developed to ensure your baby does not feel artificially propped up when crawling. The really nice thing is that they can use them inside and outside, and once they know how to crawl, they still can use them to play in the park and protect their little knees. In my case I am planning to put them on my daughter for her bike riding lessons!"



"The Snazzy Baby Travel Chair is a must-have for every traveling parent. Ok, so awesome thing #1- it rolls up into itself, so no extra bag to tote around. All-in-one! It's multi-functional, because you can use it in a shopping cart as well. Sometimes those "safety belts" aren't all that safe. Especially once your baby starts learning how to stand up."



"When I first saw all the buckles involved in the My Baby's Own Travel Chair I thought it would be confusing, but it was surprisingly easy to get my baby all buckled up. There are buckles on each side and buckles over the shoulders. Just snap those together and adjust the straps to fit your baby and you are set! Another worry I had was that I wasn't sure a cloth seat would be able to hold my baby securely in a chair. I was afraid if he wiggled at all he'd fall over, but Snazzy Baby® was a step ahead of me. They make the travel chair with a non-slip bottom so the seat won't slip around. The straps that hold the seat to a chair can be tightened to fit securely, and I had no problems with my baby wiggling around or falling over. He was snug and safe sitting on one of our dining room chairs."

"The Snazzy Baby Mom's Deluxe 3 in 1 Plus Combo Carrier should be called the 6 in one combo. This is the most versatile carrier I've come across. I particularly like how you can put baby on at the car, walk inside the store, grab a cart and within a minute your tot is secured, you never have to take him out of the carrier. When you leave the store, just unstrap a few straps and put him back on. Very easy! I also like how small it is. You can leave it in your baby bag for whenever. Another plus - how easy it is to sit and eat with my son on my lap in this carrier. Not very many carriers can claim that."

"You are probably familiar with other travel boosters that are "portable", you can take them with you to restaurants, grandma's house or anywhere else you are on the go. Snazzy Baby's Travel Chair is so much better, because it is ultra-portable! It folds up very small and fits right into the attached bag, weighing less than 7 Oz. You can store it in your diaper bag or keep it in the trunk of your car so you will always have it when you need it. I will never forget the time I was at Target. My daughter was in the shopping cart, I was looking at something for what seemed like 2 seconds, when I turned back to the cart, she was standing on the seat with a *look-what-I-can-do-mom!* expression on her face. From that day on, until I received Snazzy Baby's Travel Chair, those icky-yucky straps that have probably never been washed, to secure my daughter. I know, I am a nut, I would take spray sanitizer and spray those things down, but I could not risk having her tumble out of the cart! With the travel chair, I can just come home, throw it in the wash and let it line dry."
